ORDER No. 8. J

The Officers and men do not attend the courts for evidence on one pretext or the other on the dates fixed, although Circulars have been issued more than once in this behalf.

2. Even in Sessions cases, the officers and men fail to attend the Court on the date of hearing and the result is that complaints for non-attendance are received in this office from the Courts and the decision in important cases is unnecessarily delayed. This shows that no timely action is taken against the defaulters.

3. It is, therefore, again emphasized on all concerned that whenever an officer or man is found absent on the dates fixed for his attendance in the Court, the P.S.I. or the P.I. concerned will immediately bring this fact to the notice of the C.O. or the S.P. of the District, who will take proper action against the defaulter according to the instructions contained in PHO Circular No.73 issued under this office No.III/G-4-2-54 Part I/7965 dated 2.7.54 and will also see that the defaulter attends the court positively on the next date of hearing. In case the officer or man concerned has been transferred to other District, the S.P. will please bring this fact to the notice of the S.P. of that district through a D.O. immediately, who will be responsible to see that such defaulter attends the Court on the next date of hearing and to take proper action against him for his failure to attend the Court on the previous date.
