Instances have come to my notice that Police personnel are still being sent for Refreshers Courses or for other Training inside or outside Rajasthan without undergoing Medical Test.

This results in returning some of them to their places of postings and unnecessary expenses are incurred in the shape of T.A. Recently a man suffering from Tuberculosis was sent for some Training. This is really surprising on the part of the responsible officers who send such men for the various courses.

It is, therefore, once again enjoined upon all concerned that the trainees before being nominated and sent to any course should invariably be got thoroughly examined, through a competent Medical Officer so that such cases may not arise in future.
