It has been seen that purchases of Dana and Fodder for the Government Animals are made in piece meal 'on as and when required basis' as a Contingent Charge by most of the officers. As per rule 256 of General Financial and Account Rules purchases should be made in bulk to take advantage of rates at the harvest time.

It is, therefore, desired that all the officers, who have Government animals, should work out their total requirements for the whole year and purchase the same after calling tenders and obtaining competent sanction where necessary. Wide publicity should be given. Tenders should be invited in May - June for the articles obtainable from the Rabi Crop and in the months of November for the grain and fodder obtainable from the Kharif Crop. Any purchases made in contravention of the above procedure will not be sanctioned.
