CIRCULAR ORDER. No. 30 -

Ever since my taking over in Rajasthan, time and again directions with regard to inspections of Police Stations and Out Posts by Ss.P., Circle Officers and Circle Inspectors have been issued from the P.H.Q. in the form of Circulars and ~~th~~ in the records of the minutes of all the conferences etc. held from time to time. In spite of all this, the results of the last year showed that some of the Ss.P. had completely neglected the inspection work and some had carried out inspections of some Police Stations formerly or cursorily and their explanations had to be obtained at the instance of Govt. for onward transmission to them.

2. At the beginning of the year the Ss.P. were directed to chalk -out programmes of Inspections by them and their junior Gazetted officers and to adhere to the programme. This year every S.P. and every C.O. must complete thorough and detailed inspection of each and every P.S. and Out Post in his charge.

3. For the cities of Jaipur, Jodhour, and Udaipur the Ss.P. must divide the inspection work between them and their Additional Ss.P. and see that all the Police Stations and out-posts are thoroughly inspected by the end of the year.

4. Omission otherwise than on reasonable grounds will be viewed with seriousness and may adversely - affect the future of the Senior officers.

5. The Range D.Is.G. will please ensure that their Ss.P. comply with these instructions. They will also please carry out detailed inspections of all the districts under their charge by the end of the year.
