STANDING ORDER No. 1

Subject:- I.G.'s inspections of Districts.

The pattern of the I.G.'s annual inspection of Districts (including Railways) will ~~however~~ hereafter be as follows :

1st Day. Parade and kit inspection of Civil and Armed Police. All C.Os. to attend. (As many men and officers as possible present in the District town should attend this parade. The I.G. will see Ceremonial, Company drill, Arms drill, Bayonet fighting, Squad drill, Lathi drill, Baton drill, Riot drill, P.T., Rifle P.T., Assault Course etc. He will then inspect the kit which should be spread out according to Standing Orders).

2nd Day. Inspection of Crimex. All C.Os. to attend. The S.P. will keep ready crime statements in the form ordered in this office Standing Order No. 60 dated the 19th December, 1955 for the current year and the two preceding years. The I.G. will also go round the S.P.'s office and look into maintenance of Service Rolls, strength of men (separate for armed and unarmed branches) for each Police Station and Lines and their housing accomodation, some departmental proceedings (including those pending), Orderly Room registers of S.P., office copies of Monthly Crime Reviews of S.P., welfare activities, sports fund, inspection notes of Police Stations, by S.P., disposal of work in his office, inspection of Police Stations and Outposts by S.P. and C.Os., personal investigations by C.Os. who are direct recruits, flying squads in City Police Stations. Buildings Register maintained by S.P., Police Cooperative Societies (where they exist), progress in drill training and any other items of importance.

3rd Day. Conference of all Police officers of and above the rank of Sub-Inspector in the District. The I.G. will then see all local Police buildings.

4th Day. Hold Orderly Room and read inspection notes. In this Orderly Room, any officer or man or clerk of the District, who has any grievance or request to make to the I.G. can attend after first sending his application. The S.P. should therefore inform all his subordinates and invite applications as above. The I.G. will then issue orders as to who should be ~~xxx~~ called for Orderly Room. All C.Os. should attend.

2. Full dress should be worn on the 1st and 3rd day by all officers.

3. In small Districts, the I.G. may spend only 3 days by combining the work of the 2nd and the 3rd day.

4. Before he visits the Districts, the I.G. will issue a very brief inspection programme on the above lines quoting therein this standing order. Ss.P. concerned will immediately refer to the latter and make full arrangements for the inspection.
