STANDING ORDER NO. 9

Sub:- Special Report cases.

The policy regarding submission of Special Reports and Continuation Re-ports has been revised and following instructions are issued in partial modification of circular No.155 and No.45 dated 13.11.54 and 6.9.55 respectively.

(1) Cases of embezzlement of public money.

In cases of embezzlement of public money, S.Rs. are to be sent to Govt. only in those cases in which money involved is more than Rs.500/-. S.Rs. and C.Rs. of all cases of embezzlement of public money shall however be sent to the C.I.D.

(2) Riots.

At present every riot which takes place between two parties over land is considered as Agrarian and Special Reports are submitted to Govt. and the C.I.D. In future only those <sup>cases</sup> of Agrarian riots shall be treated as Special Report cases which have either resulted in murder or which have been organised or instigated by political parties.

(3) Loss or theft of fire-arms other than those belonging to Govt.:-

Special Reports are not to be sent to Govt. and are to be sent only to the C.I.D. as heretofore.

(4) Counterfeiting of coins and forging of stamps and G.C. Notes.

Special Reports are not to be sent to Govt. and are to be sent only to the C.I.D. as heretofore.
