STANDING ORDER NO. 1/A.

In supersession of all previous orders and instructions regarding practical training of Probationary Prosecuting Sub-Inspectors the following orders are issued for being adhered to strictly:-

(1) On appointment to a district as Prosecuting Sub-Inspector on probation, the officer will go through a course of practical training for 12 months,

(2) This course will consist of two periods:-

(a) During the period of first 4 months the officer will be attached to a big Police Station for learning and watching investigation work and getting himself acquainted with all registers, forms etc. concerning crime.

(b) During the period of next eight month the officer will be attached to a Prosecuting Inspector.

(3) The Probationary officer should conduct at least 6 cases on his own but under the supervision of the Prosecuting Inspector during the latter period.
