The matter with regard to disposal of cases of drawal of false T.A. was discussed in the cabinet meeting held on 29th June, 1959. The cabinet has taken decision that in all pending cases of malafide intentions on the part of the officers to over draw the amount of T.A. bills, the punishment should be stoppage of three increments with cumulative effect. For future, if there be any malafide intention to over draw the amount of T.A. bill, the punishment should be removal or dismissal from service. Any technical mistake in the drawal of T.A. should, however, be decided on individual merit of the case.

2. It is, therefore, desired that all cases of drawal of false T.A. should now be disposed of as per decision of the cabinet. Genl.
