STANDING ORDER NO. 4

Sub: Procedure of Training & Re-examination
of failures in Promotion Cadre Courses.

Reference is invited to Rule 28(2) of the Rajasthan Police Subordinate Service Rules, 1974 which lays down the provision of further training for those who fail to pass the Promotion Cadre Course Examination. The following policy is laid down in this matter:-

(1) Those candidates who fail in one or two papers in an indoor subject in any P.C.C. would report to the respective Training Institution which conducts the P.C.C. examination for re-examination in the concerned subjects three days before the actual commencement of the examination. Intimation of the dates of the examination shall be sent well in advance by the Principal/Commandant of the respective Training Institution to the Distt. S.P./Bn./Office along with a copy for the candidate.

(2) Those candidates who fail in one or two subjects in out-door shall report to the respective Training Institutions two weeks before the actual date of examination which will be intimated well in advance by the respective Principal/Commandant to the Distt. S.P./Bn./Office, in one or two papers.

This period is provided to give an opportunity to the failure to brush up his knowledge in out-door subject at the Training Institution itself. Such facility may not be available at the place of the failure candidate. However, in cases where facilities exist it shall be for the candidate to decide in consultation with his Head of office whether he would like to forego the facility to brush up his knowledge in out-door subject at the Training Institution and would like to appear at the examination only. In that case the candidate will report to the concerned Training Institution three days before the actual date of examination.

(3) Candidates who fail in more than two subjects in out-door or indoor or both shall be required to undergo full training in the following batch. Where following batch is provided they shall be asked to appear in the examination at the place of the out-door subject.

to join the new batch as & when it is called provided such a batch is called within one year of his first examination. Even where no such batch is possible, the failure candidate shall be put through a special batch arranged for the purpose.

- (4) There would be cases in which a candidate may pass in all the subjects but fails in the aggregate. Such cases would be rare and have to be examined minutely by the Examination Board but where the performance of the candidate is just at the minimum in most subjects, it shall be proper to ask the candidate to re-appear in all the subjects.
- (5) Candidates some time fail in one or two subjects in out-door or in-door/ ^{and} such candidates may also fail in the aggregate. If the minimum or reasonable marks in the subjects in which a candidate has failed when added to the aggregate make up the required aggregate, the candidate shall be asked to appear only in the subjects in which he has failed. If the margin is greater which possibly could be made up by obtaining high marks but not necessarily full marks allotted for the subject in which the candidate has failed, it shall be open to the candidate to decide whether he would like to reappear only in those subjects in which he has failed or would like to re-appear as a whole. This choice has to be exercised by the candidate and intimated to the respective Principal/Commandant of the Training Institution well in advance of the next examination through his superior officer. This assumes greater importance as under the two chances are allowed for appearing in the and the second chance becomes all the more in when the first chance has been lost.
