SYLLABUS FOR PROMOTION CADRE COURSE OF S. Is FIT FOR
PROMOTION AS INSPECTORS IN FINGER PRINT BUREAU VIDE
RULE 27(2) OF RAJASTHAN POLICE SUB-ORDINATE SERVICES
RULES, 1974.

In exercise of the powers vested in me under the rules of the Rajasthan Police Sub-ordinate Services Rules, 1974, I prescribe the following syllabus for the Promotion Cadre Course of the S. Is for the Promotion to the rank of Inspectors (Civil Police) in the Rajasthan State Finger Print Bureau.

The syllabus for the training is prescribed as under. The duration of this course will be for four months.

FIRST MONTH:-

a) SINGLE DIGIT WORK:

Study of working of different systems of classification and the practicability of any one of them and which may be used officially in Rajasthan Bureau. Each candidate will be required to study this system properly and they will submit a paper at the end of their training. This will be of 100 marks.

b) CONSTITUTION AND FINGER PRINTS:

The rights of Police Officials and the criminals with regards to taking the finger prints, important rulings etc. Validity of Experts testimony with regards to the comparison of friction skin and important court rulings concerning them. These subjects will be taught by the Director, Finger print bureau and there will be an examination of this course having 100 marks.

SECOND AND THIRD MONTHS:

a) FOOT AND SHOE PRINTS:

Study of foot and shoe prints, their comparison and method of submitting the cases in courts. Each candidate will be required to prepare a detailed lecture note covering all aspects of this science including their evidentiary value in the court and giving important court judgements and rulings. This paper will be of 100 marks.

b) OTHER METHODS OF COMPARISON OF FRICTION SKIN :

- i) Poroscopy;
- ii) Edgeoscopy;
- iii) Ectodactylism and Polydactylism and system of recording of prints in such cases.
- iv) No. of points required for the definite opinions. Opinion of different Experts on this subject and candidate's own conclusion regarding minimum No. of ridge characteristics he thinks sufficient for definite opinion. This will also cover the study of evolution of different characteristics.

The candidates will be required to submit a paper on these subjects (i, II, III and iv above). This will be of 100 marks.

FOURTH MONTH:

STUDY TOUR

After the completion of the above training candidates will be sent to the Central Finger Print Bureau, Calcutta, Finger Print Bureau, Patna and Madras. They will study the working of the Foot Print Bureau there. In Tamilnadu they will make a special study of Single Digit Sections of 2-3-cities.

After return from study tour they will submit their study report which will be examined. This will of 100 marks.

As indicated above the total examination marks will be 500 for five papers i.e. 100 marks for each paper. The pass marks will be 50% with an aggregate of 60% marks.

Unsuccessful persons will be allowed to appear twice after a gap of one month in the subject in which he fails any person who fails to pass in the second attempt will be debarred from further appearance. Any person who fails in two subjects/papers and also does not make an aggregate of marks shall have to undergo full promotion cadre course.

BOARD OF EXAMINATION:

A board consisting of the following will be constituted to examine the papers submitted by the candidates and to take final examination and declare result on being approved by the I.G.P. Rajasthan:-
