In continuation of this office circular No.94 dated 11-8-1954 the attention of the heads of offices is drawn to Rule 66 of the General Financial and Account Rules according to which they are required to record an annual certificate in the Service Books of the employees serving under them. Regarding the verification of service, and also give a certificate at the time of transfer in the Service Book regarding verification of services from the pay bills and Acquittance Rolls in respect of the whole period during which a Government servant was employed under him, before forwarding the service book to the other office where his services are transferred. The Officer under whom his services have been transferred should not accept the service book unless the above certificate is given therein. At the time of inspection the absence of this certificate in the service book will be considered as an omission on the part of the office of the Officer under whom the employee is transferred.
