CIRCULAR ORDER NO. 114

It has come to the notice of the I.G. of Police that literate constables who are Middle Pass or above are not being paid literacy allowance. When questioned in one of the District Offices as to why this was not being paid to them, it was replied by the Force clerk that the cases of such personnel were pending for want of the S.P's sanctioning order. This shows that the Ss.P. have not been looking after the interests of their personnel. A date should be fixed by each S.P. for calling all the literate constables with their Middle Pass or above certificates and after examining them he should pass orders for the drawal of their due literacy allowance. Compliance of this should be made within a month and a report submitted to PHQ. If any instance of non-payment of literacy allowance to a person, who is entitled to it comes to the notice of the IGP, he will be constrained to take a serious notice thereof.

2. With regard to fresh enlistments, now that the order is that no body who is not Middle Pass should be enlisted, the candidate's Middle certificate should be examined before enlistment and he should be paid the literacy allowance from the date of recruitment.
