It has been observed that the Dy. Inspector General of Police, RAC., realised an entry fee from all the Units which participated in the tournament held by him last year. This entry fee was drawn from the Government Funds, which amounted to transfer of funds within the Department to a head which was not subject to audit. This procedure adopted by the Deputy Inspector General of Police was irregular. The Government has already sanctioned a provision for such expenditure under "Games and Sports". The legitimate expenditure incurred on such tournaments should be debited to that head.

The Deputy Inspectors General of Police should ask for funds from this office when they hold tournaments. Their proposals should be supported by a detailed estimate of expenditure for obtaining sanction of the Inspector General of Police. The expenditure incurred by them will be drawn by them from the Treasury on Contingent Bills debitable to the appropriate budget head.
