6. All urgent cases to be disposed of by ACSH in the absence of the Minister, Home Guard from the headquarters provided the case is of such a nature that it cannot await the arrival of the minister, but such decision should be brought to the notice of the Minister later.

7. Group Officer/DS in the absence of JS may dispose of urgent case.

8. Cases not covered by the above items will be examined by Group Officer/DS/JS and put

up to the ACSH through the HS for orders.
